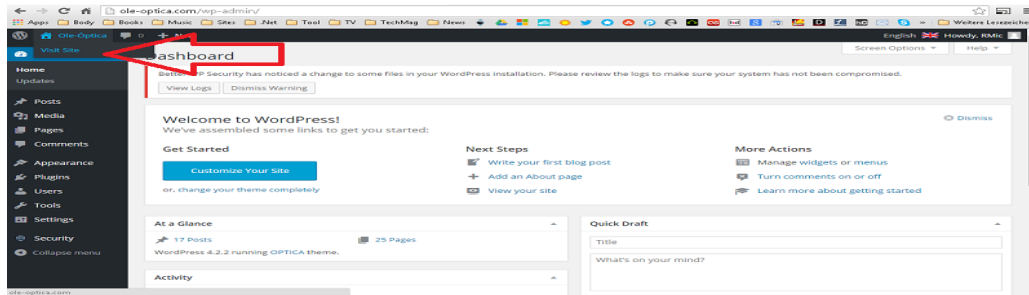
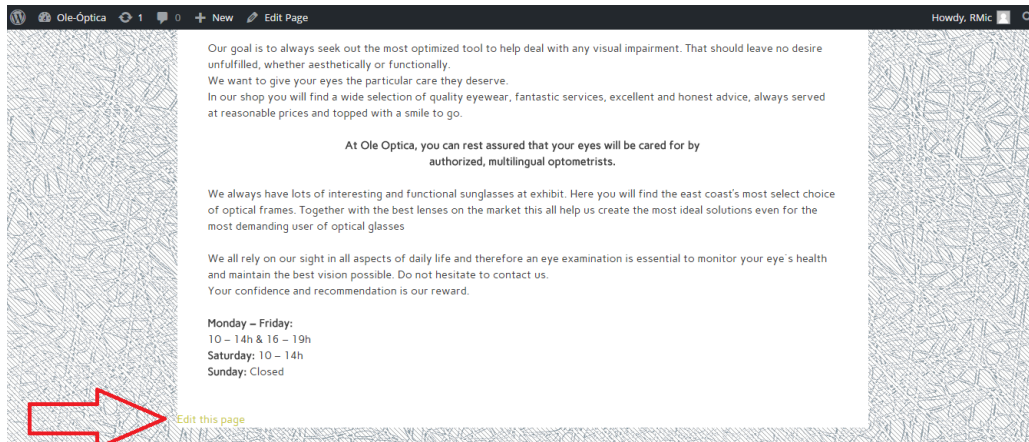


# Pages - Edit the content of a subpage

- In the Wordpress-Dashboard click on **visit site** in the top left corner



- The Ole-Optics homepage opens. Now navigate to the page you would like to modify.
- Every page you open -except the home-page- there is an **edit-link** on the left/bottom corner of the page:



- By clicking on this *edit-link*, the corresponding page opens in edit mode and you will be able to modify the page content.
